### Ancestry website

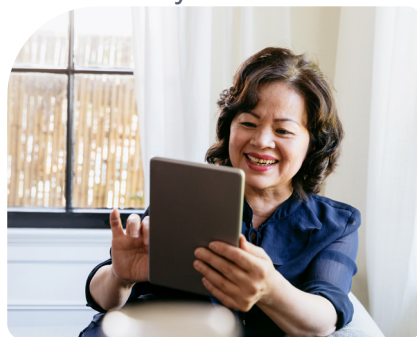

### Find my Past

Using the computers at your local library you can get full access to England, Wales and Scotland's census records and easy-to-search birth, marriage and death records. Find my Past has the UK's largest collection of parish records, historical British newspapers and much more.

### Search the 1921 census

Available on Find my Past the 1921 census provides a fascinating insight into the 38 million lives from that year and the society at the time.

### Britannica Library

Access the online version of the world famous encyclopaedia, offering trusted information from three sites in one: Britannica online, Britannica Junior online, Britannica Student online. Easily carry out research and complete homework projects. You can store your research in your own personal 'My Britannica' account. Access the Britannica Library site then enter your library card number in the log in box to begin.
